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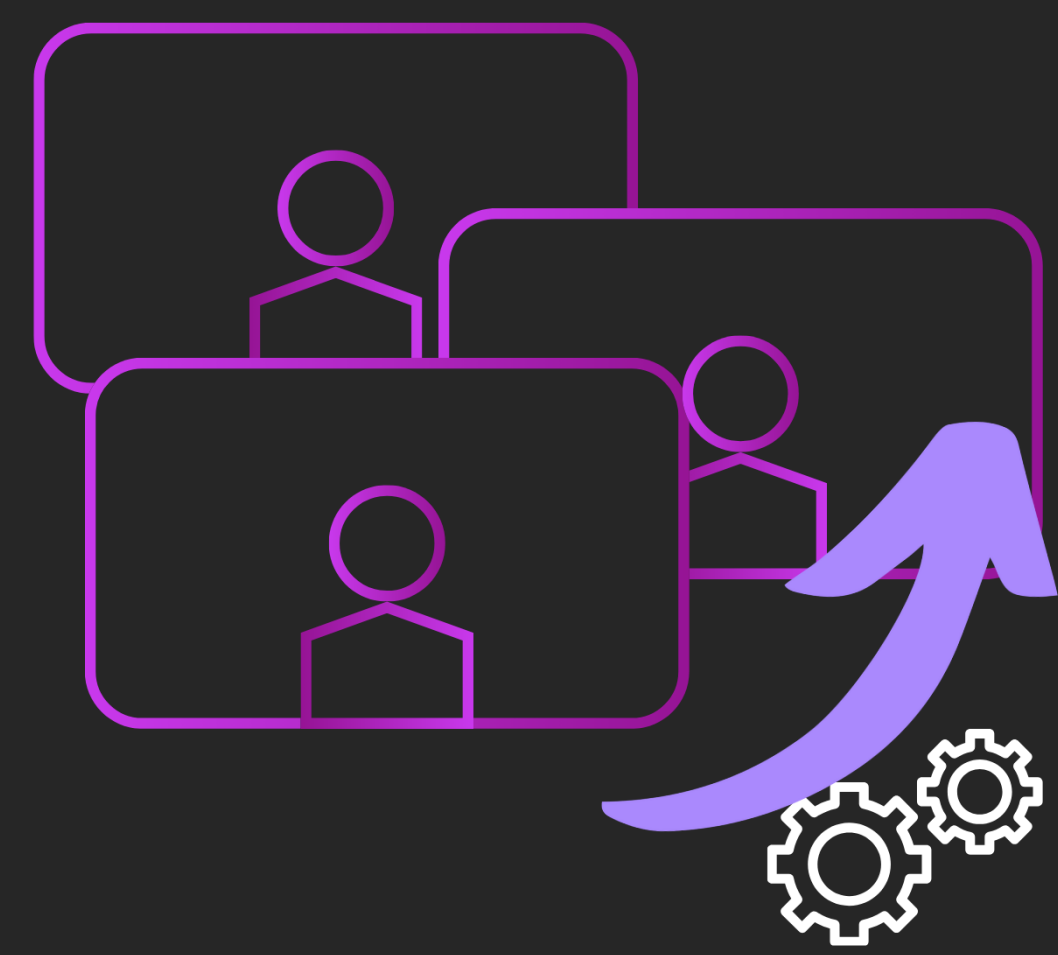
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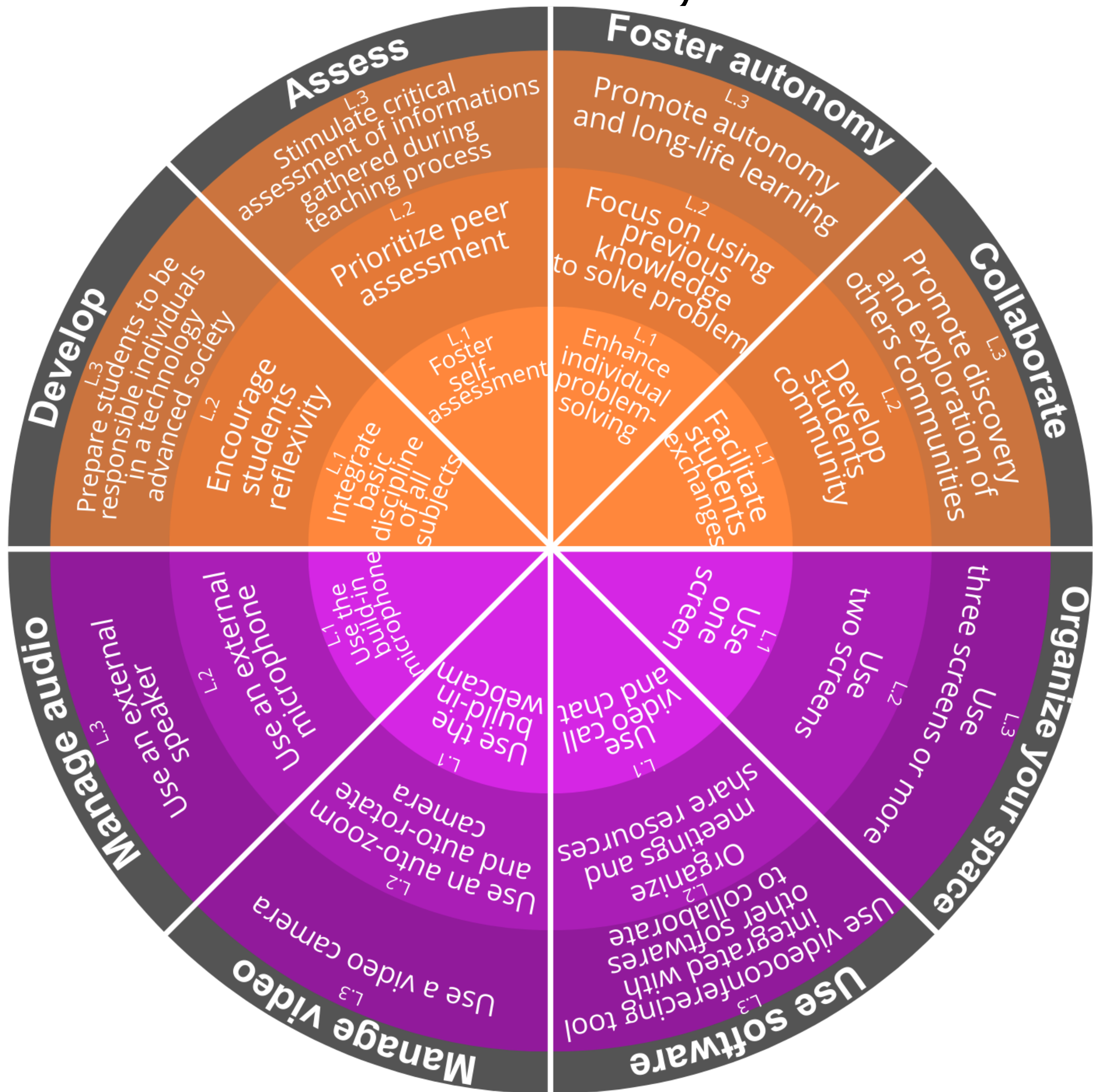

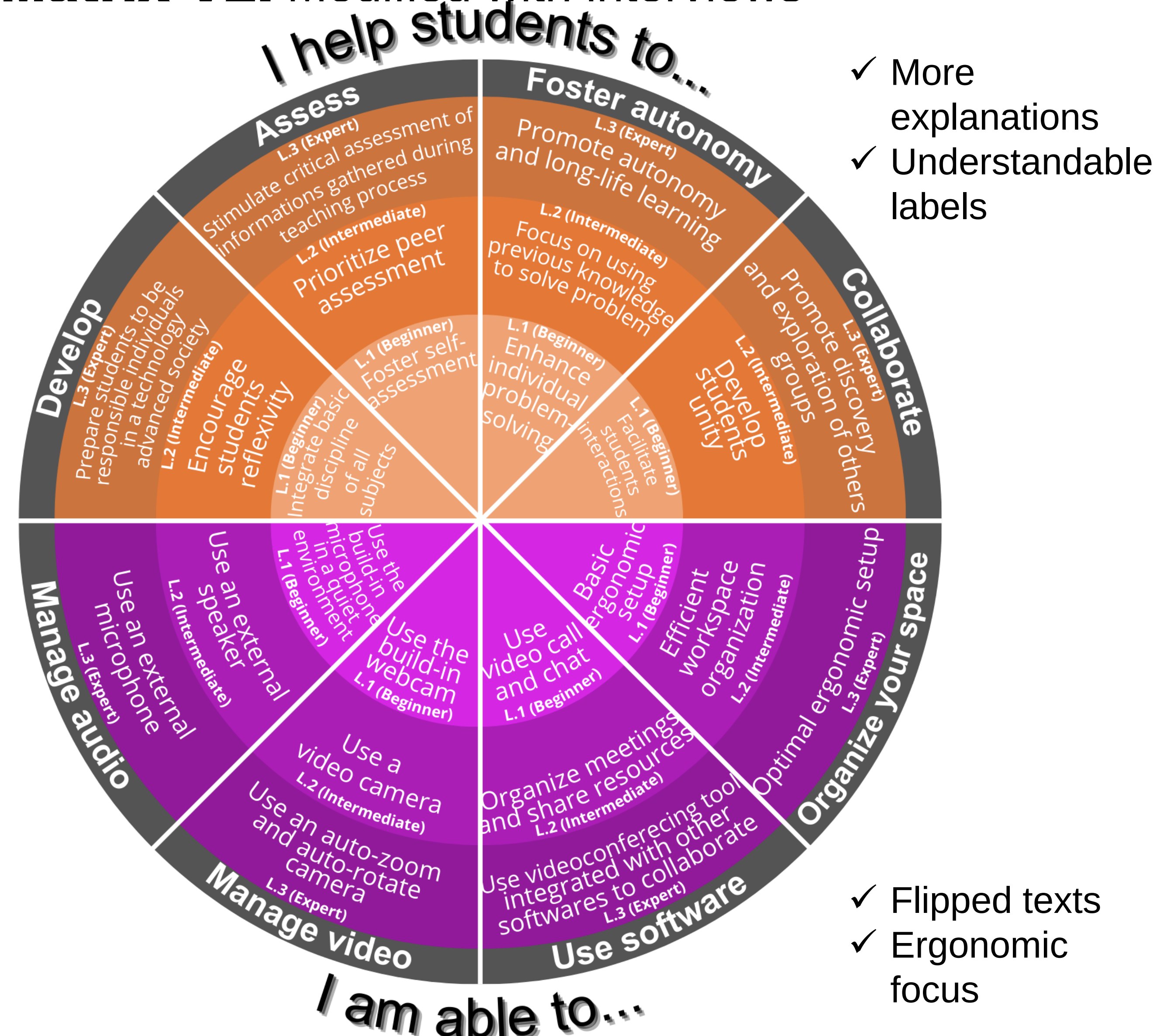
EdViCon project: creating a competence matrix for videoconferencing

Matrix V1: Based on survey results

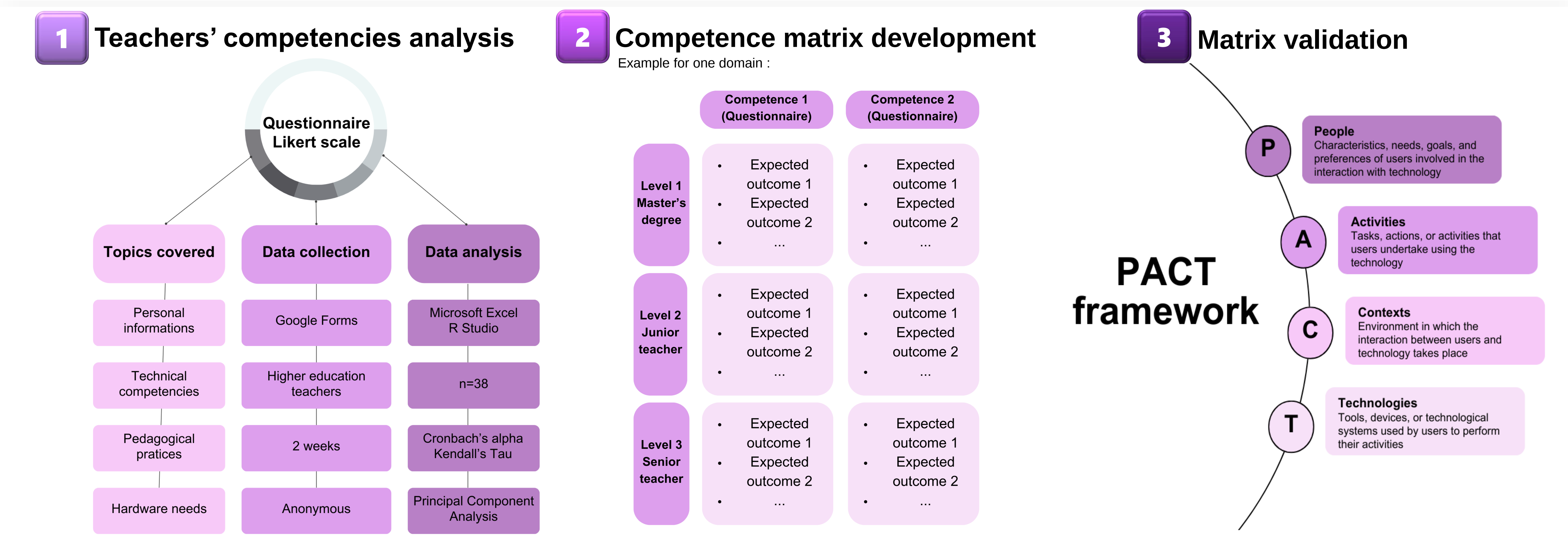


Matrix V2: Modified with interviews
